When you're prepared for an emergency, you know what to do and you have what you need to stay safe.


You can be ready too!

So Ready came in, dried off his wet fur...














"Our emergency kit is for storms or other natural disasters. If people can't help us, we need to be able to help ourselves. Come, see the kit." Ready's dad explained.

"These items are on our state's Department of Safety website. So we made a kit ahead of time in case something, like this storm, were to happen."






